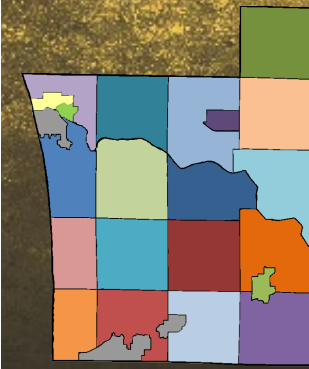

The 2022 Annual Report provides a statistical and informational document of the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office and the activities of 2022. This report is only a snapshot of the services and what the Sheriff's Office accomplishes daily throughout the county.

Members of the Sheriff's Office serve with Professionalism, Respect, Integrity, Dedication, Excellence, Equality, and Diversity. The Sheriff's Office's primary mission is to provide a safe and secure environment to the citizens and visitors of Ottawa County by preserving public order and supporting the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Michigan by the enforcement of state and local laws.

Our goal is to identify, understand and address the issues in our communities. We accomplish this through collaborative efforts, and problem-solving, with our citizens and community partners. We will continue to collaborate to enhance services as the needs of our communities change with the growth that we are experiencing.

In 2022, we responded to an increased number of calls for service. We had a very slight increase in Index and Non-Index crimes, numbers almost equal to 2021. Overall arrests are up 6% compared to 2021. For a third year in a row, traffic crashes increased, up 9% compared to 2021. We will remain vigilant in addressing issues, traffic education and enforcement, investigating criminal incidents and responding to calls for service.

Our Correctional Deputies are dedicated to providing safe, secure, and professional services to our citizen detainees in the jail facility. Court Security Deputies continue to maintain and provide a safe environment and assist citizens at the court facilities in our county. Our jail education programs continue for the citizen detainees. Several new programs were added in 2022 to assist our citizen detainees be better prepared for success as they return to the community.

We are proud of the professionalism, dedication, and work ethic of the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office staff. We will continue to provide professional and quality law enforcement services to our citizens and visitors while keeping victims of crime our top priority. We would like to thank the County Board of Commissioners and County Administration for your support. We remain thankful to all our community partners, local public safety partners, and our citizens of Ottawa County.

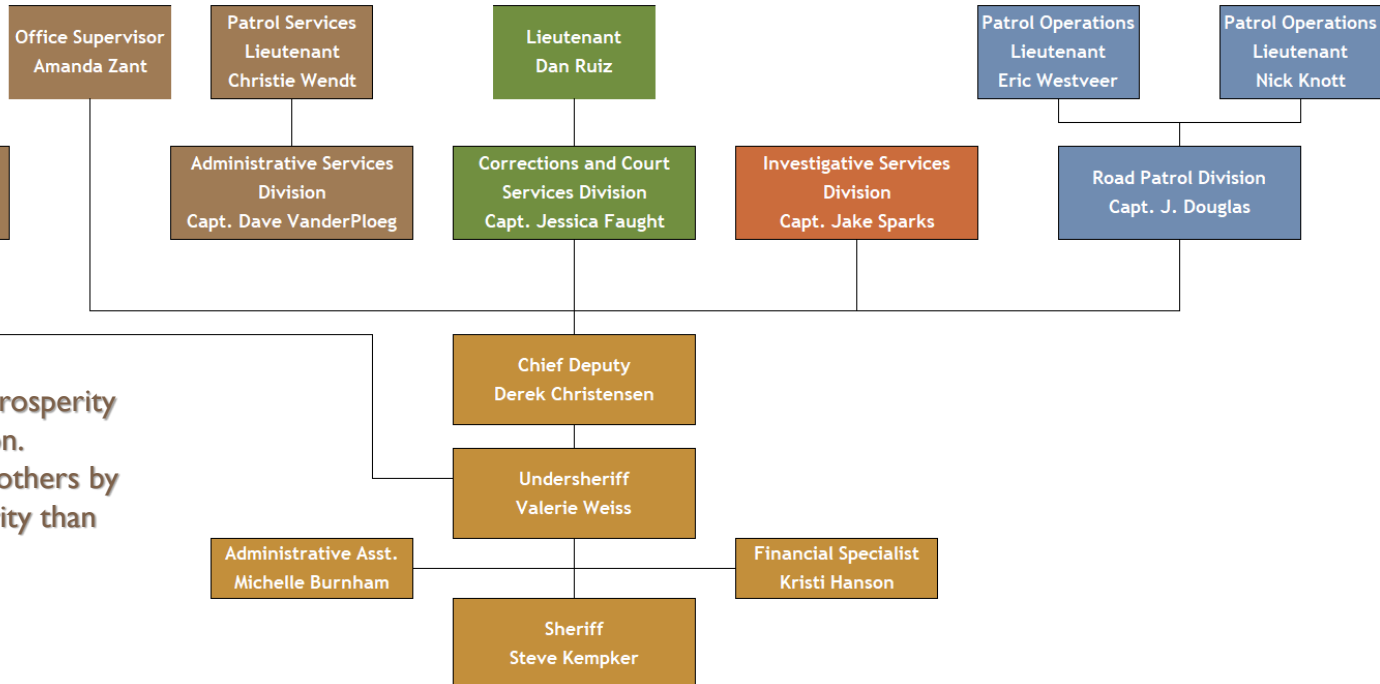


Ottawa County Sheriff's Office Administrative Team

Corrections and Court Services Division

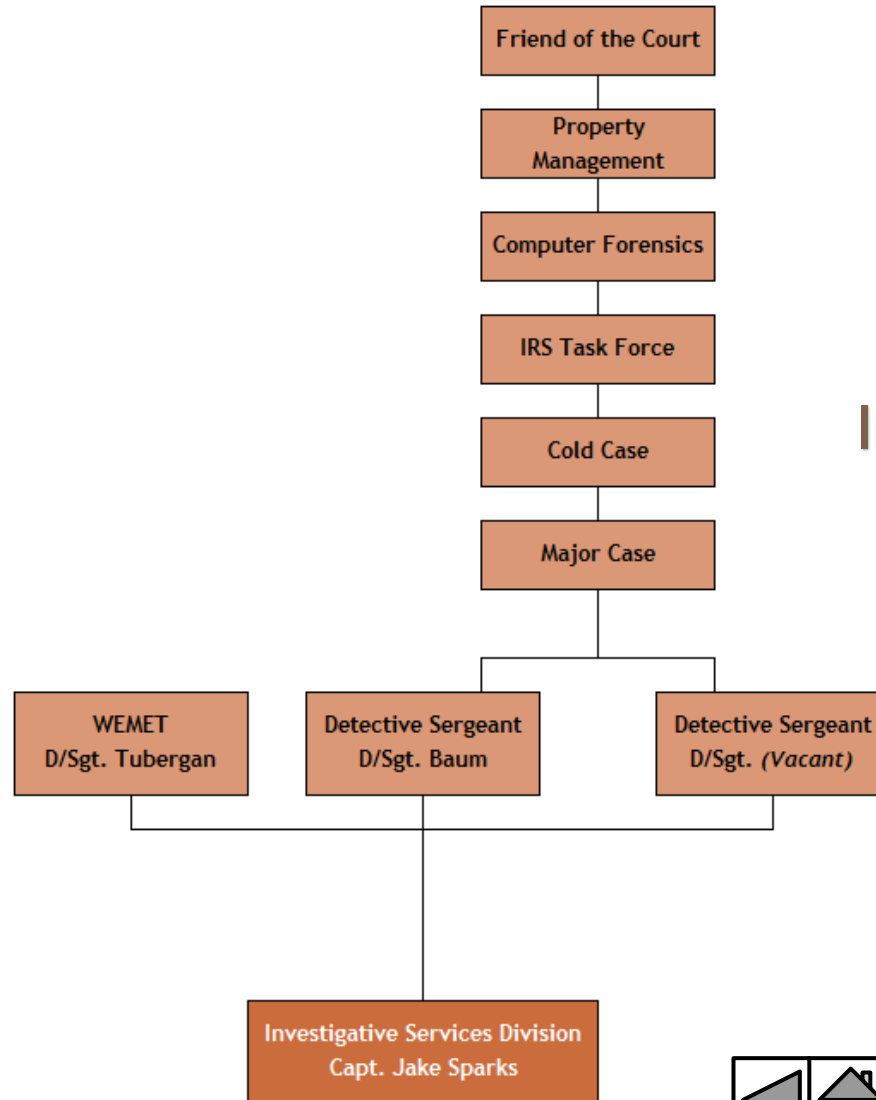

Road Patrol Division

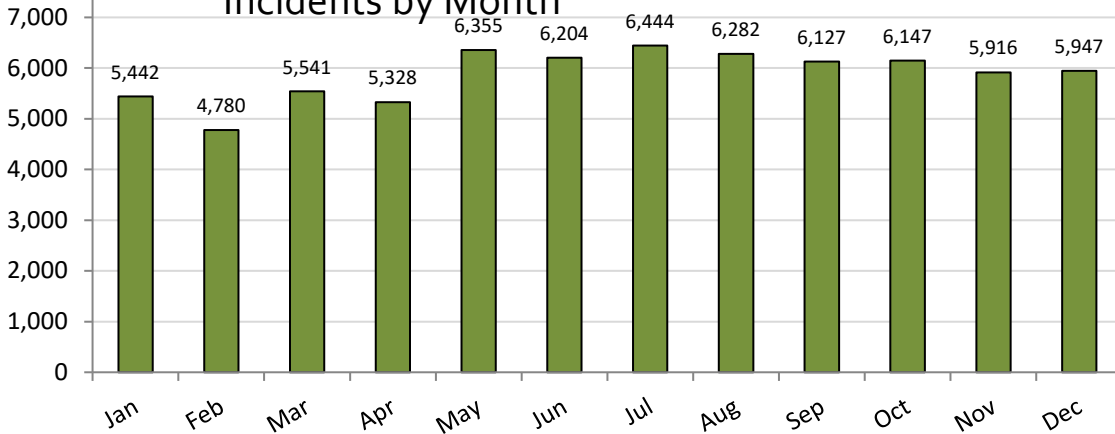

Incidents by Day of Week / Hour of Day



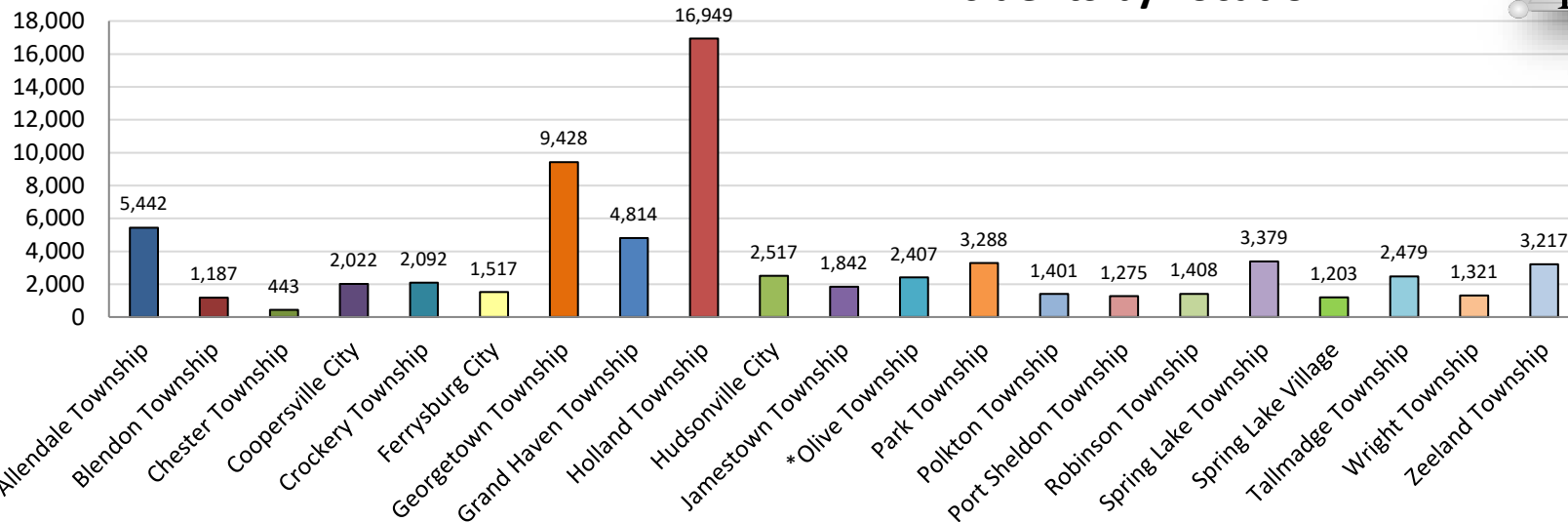

Mission

The mission of Emergency Management is to protect the lives and property of the people of Ottawa County, and the environment, through hazard mitigation, emergency preparedness, response, and recovery as this pertains to emergencies and disasters.

Response and Preparedness

Emergency Management responded to multiple emergency events in 2022, including flooding, power outages, hazardous materials, search and rescue operations, the COVID-19 pandemic, and many others. Severe weather events in Ottawa County included significant responses, with storm effects such as wind damage, flooding, high heat, blizzard conditions, and power outages. There were also emergencies involving hazardous materials such as a chlorine release at a local aquatic center. Through our hazmat team, emergency management and local and state officials, significant progress was made in 2022 working towards emergency preparedness at a local

chemical business of interest that has partnered with us to improve public safety. Our Technical Rescue Team also responded to multiple calls for service, including a recovery operation that involved trenching and extracting part of a buried drainage system, and shoring up a compromised structure that had been impacted by a vehicle. In addition, the Technical Rescue Team took delivery in 2022 of a new dedicated truck and trailer to enhance response and capability. Numerous emergency preparedness tips were distributed on social media throughout the year. Hazard Mitigation is also a component of preparedness, and a lot of work was conducted in 2022 to finish updating the Ottawa/Kent/Grand Rapids City hazard mitigation plan and send it to FEMA for review. In 2023, the Hazard Mitigation Plan will be adopted by included jurisdictions in Ottawa County for full FEMA approval and then used as a living guidance document.

Training and Exercise

Multiple tabletop exercises and trainings were conducted in 2022. A cyber exercise, funded by Emergency Management Local Planning Team funds was hosted by the Ottawa County Information Technology department and drew in a wide variety of IT

professionals to test cyber threat response. The Local Emergency Planning Committee and Emergency Management coordinated a very successful countywide shelter in place drill for chemical emergencies, that will become a yearly exercise to build capability. Our hazmat team hosted a very successful statewide hazardous materials exercise in 2022 that included teams from across the state as well as federal assets. The much-anticipated Mass Casualty Incident tabletop and full-scale exercise were conducted in 2022 and were a huge success. The MCI exercises were a collaboration between the Ottawa Medical Control Board Authority, the Local Planning Team Training and Exercise Subcommittee, Ottawa County Emergency Management, and our local partners in public safety and hospitals. These exercises will become yearly, rotating through different locations in the county to train and challenge as many departments and responders as possible. The yearly active shooter/rescue task force training and exercise was conducted at Grand Valley State University to prepare Ottawa area first responders to work together to address the threat and render triage, treatment and transport of injured persons. 2022 was a very active year in training and exercise in Ottawa County.

Homeland Security

Ottawa County Emergency Management is well represented at the Region 6 Homeland Security Board where the Ottawa County Director of Emergency Management is the Regional Chair and the Ottawa County Homeland Security Planner is the Subcommittee Chair; both also serving on the Executive Committee. In 2022 our local Homeland Security Planner coordinated projects within Ottawa County that strengthened incident response and enhanced public protection. Exercises were a strong focus and involved law enforcement, fire department personnel and other first responders and provided the ability to practice and enhance community response capability. Our Homeland Security Planner also continued to

Our Homeland Security Planner also continued to provide incident awareness and response training for Court personnel to enhance emergency response and protection for Court House staff as well as community members involved in Court activities. Further planning and preparation activities with The Ottawa County Alert System was a high priority for our Homeland Security Planner in 2022. This alert system provides instant emergency notifications to the public via cell phone should the need for evacuation, shelter in place or any other activity to be quickly communicated to keep the community safe.

Local Emergency Planning Committee

Our local LEPC coordinator updated the SARA Title III, Section 302 (Emergency Response) template with the State of Michigan and updated numerous response plans. Section 302-sites are those that have been deemed to exceed a specific threshold for hazardous substances under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA). Emergency response plans for those sites are critical to first responders such as local Fire Departments to understand the hazards present and how to effectively combat them when responding to an emergency. Emergency Management/LEPC and the Ottawa County Hazardous Materials Team responded to several hazardous materials incidents throughout 2022. All issues were resolved with an emphasis on public safety and protection of the environment. One of the tabletop exercises incorporated into the 2022 LEPC Conference included response and recovery. The scenario was a widespread power outage that affected most if not all of Ottawa County, and was particularly impactful to critical infrastructure and businesses that contain hazardous materials. The conference was a huge success and many participants were eager to continue the exercise, and spend even more time discussing the recovery phase. This will help to guide future LEPC conferences and group exercises.

Emergency Operations Center and Resource Management

The Ottawa County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is an operational asset to response coordination in the county. The EOC is a secure location, equipped with technology, for representatives from multiple response disciplines to collaborate for efficient response and quick recovery from emergency/disaster. The EOC was used for training, exercises, and **EOC personnel** were used to monitor planned events with the potential for threats. An initiative to increase the number of trained personnel in the EOC (depth at all positions) began in 2020, continued in 2021 and has progressed through 2022. This depth at positions ensures the EOC can staff long activations that involve multiple operational periods.

Emergency Management Volunteers

Emergency Management has almost 150 dedicated volunteers in Medical Reserve Corps (MRC), Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), Search & Rescue (SAR), Auxiliary Emergency Communications (OCEC), Sky warn, Hudsonville

Emergency Services, Traffic Services, Volunteer Funding Team, Canteen Services and Special Events. Together, these volunteers put in thousands of hours of specialized training and service, working events and responses for emergencies.

Two significant expansions of our **Volunteer Services** occurred in 2022, including the newly formed Volunteer Funding Team and elevating Canteen to team status. The structure and materials for the Volunteer Funding Team were established in 2022, and in 2023 the team will be making inroads with donors interested in furthering the mission of our Emergency Management volunteers in Ottawa County. Elevating Canteen to team status was an easy decision, with a high demand for their services at lengthy public safety operations. The Team Leader of Canteen Services was also chosen as the 2022 Volunteer of the Year for the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office.

Both **Canteen Services**, and all our Volunteer Teams, are a force multiplier for **Emergency Management** and an asset to Ottawa County.

Records Management

The **records unit** merged 53,336 field reports from officers and detectives in 2022. The clerks transcribe officer reports, distribute subpoenas for service, enter case data, and scan documents into our records management system.

Requests under the Freedom of Information Act are processed daily in the order they are received. We processed 4,037 FOIA requests from the public. **Save time, paper and money using the [Ottawa County FOIA Center](#) to submit requests.** Most requests are processed electronically for less than \$10.00. Online payment is available when a fee is charged.

Entering handgun registrations is a daily task. Records staff entered 8,327 registrations into the State's system. **Applications for License to Purchase** result in approval for most while they wait. In 2022, we accepted 506 applications of which 17 of those were denied.

Records staff at the West Olive Adult Correctional Facility scheduled 6,973 visits for inmates during the year. These include family and professional visits.

Fingerprinting remains in high demand. We printed 2,415 people in the Records Office in 2022. We fingerprint general applicants such as school employment; and Court orders resulting from charges that did not require lodging in the jail.

Records personnel are available weekdays from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. at the Sheriff's Office headquarters and Jail offices in West Olive, and at the Spring Lake branch office.

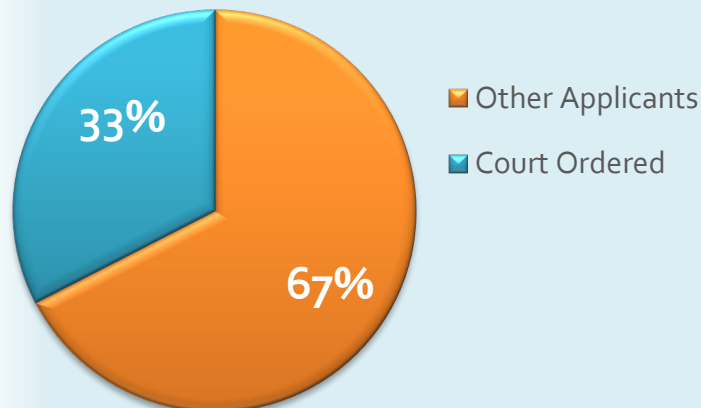

Throughout the year, department personnel receive a significant amount of **training** in various knowledge and skill areas. Training comes from a variety of sources, including departmental **in-service training** sessions, on-line training through PoliceOne Training Academy, and specialized training where an employee is sent outside the department for training. Many of these specialized training sessions are sponsored by the **West Michigan Criminal Justice Training Consortium (WMCJTC)**.

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office was instrumental in forming **WMCJTC** and continues to maintain a leadership role in the organization of 78 law enforcement agencies.

It is our continued goal to provide quality relevant training opportunities for our staff. We utilize several instructor schools to develop expertise within our training staff. This allows us to maintain high skill-levels without bearing the cost of sending all staff away to training.

The primary goal of the **Corrections Division** is to ensure the safety of inmates, corrections personnel, and residents of Ottawa County. This is accomplished by detaining inmates in a secure manner, in the least restrictive setting possible, given inmate classification.

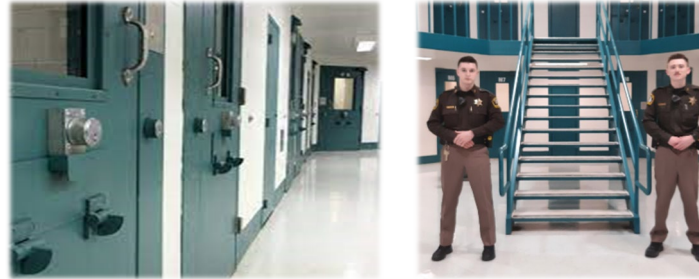
The **Corrections Division** strives to provide all inmates with humane living conditions and to protect inmate rights consistent with the United States Constitution, the Michigan Constitution, Michigan law, and Michigan Department of Corrections guidelines.

The **Corrections Division** operates the jail facility located at the Fillmore Street Complex in West Olive. The Jail is designed to hold 462 pretrial and sentenced inmates in pod-style or dormitory-style systems depending on inmate security classification. The unit is responsible for inmate holding areas located in each of the court buildings in the county.

Inmates who qualify may participate in a **Work Release Program**, allowing them the opportunity to maintain employment while they are serving their sentence.

The assessment and care for inmates that suffer from mental illness is a significant component of daily operations at the facility. Through our partnership with **Ottawa County Community Mental Health**, we have two full-time masters level clinicians who provide a variety of mental health services including risk assessment, evaluation and referral, short-term crisis therapy, case management and assistance with re-entry. One full time peer recovery coach provides support to inmates currently in recovery, and those motivated towards achieving recovery. The recovery coach initiates services while an individual is incarcerated, and support continues after release from our facility. Additionally, one part-time masters level clinician provides **Substance Use Disorder (SUD)** specific assessment and referral. The

needs and attempt to divert a person from incarceration into treatment.



Programs

The goal of these various programs is to assist inmates in becoming law abiding, productive members of the community once they are released from incarceration.

- » **General Equivalency Diploma** – offered through Zeeland Public Schools for the West Olive facility
- » **New Beginnings** – presented by the Women's Resource Center aims to reduce recidivism, provide equitable service access for female offenders, and increase the economic self-sufficiency of women returning to the community after incarceration.
- » **Thinking for a Change** – a cognitive approach program designed to change offender behavior utilizing problem solving, cognitive restructuring, and social skills interventions.
- » **Religious Programs** – offered through Reach the Forgotten and includes group services and individual study lessons. Area churches continue to be involved in our Jail Ministries Program.
- » **Substance Abuse Programs** – inmates who wish to receive support for drug and alcohol dependency can enroll in Alcoholics Anonymous support groups and other substance abuse classes.

Responsibilities

The **Corrections Division** provides building security to the courthouses in Holland, Grand Haven, Hudsonville, and the Family/Juvenile Court in West Olive. Deputies screen members of the public for weapons and contraband at the entrance to all facilities.

In addition, deputies respond to court panic alarms, provide security to people leaving the building when requested, assist probation and parole, and respond to calls for medical assistance within the facility. All corrections deputies have received training in both first aid and CPR.

Major Case Investigations

On **February 17**, around 11:00 a.m. 31-year-old Leticia Gonzales ran her SUV off the roadway on James St. in Holland Township. Her vehicle overturned and crashed into an icy pond. All three of her young children on board drowned, despite efforts of several responding deputies, who dove in the ice-covered water to attempt to free them. They were ages one, three and four. Detectives joined the investigation with the Traffic Services Unit due to the complex nature of the case. It was determined that Gonzales had obtained and used synthetic opioid medication, in excess of her prescribed amount. Gonzales was charged with three counts of Operating while Intoxicated Causing Death and is awaiting trial.

On **March 28**, 56-year-old David Martinez went to confront his ex-girlfriend at a business on Douglas Avenue in Holland Township. He assaulted the victim and attempted to shoot her in the head with a handgun. She blocked the gun and was shot in the hand. The firearm was later determined to be a pneumatic pellet pistol. Martinez fled the scene and was quickly identified and located by Sheriff's deputies, barricaded in an apartment on Falcon Lane in Holland Township. After several hours, he was safely taken into custody by the OCSO Critical Response Team. Martinez was found guilty of Assault with Intent to Commit Great Bodily Harm Less than Murder and various Domestic Violence and Weapons offenses. In November 2022, he was sentenced to 300-900 months in prison.

On **July 11**, deputies were dispatched to a home in Olive Township after two children fled the home and summoned a neighbor to call for help. Upon arrival, deputies located 32-year-old Quinn Hallacy dead inside the home. Investigation showed that 45-year-old Matthew Hallacy had stabbed his wife multiple times, causing her death. The victim's three minor children were present in the home at the time of the murder. Matthew fled the scene, taking one of the children with him. Matthew was located by police soon after the incident and arrested. He was charged with Open Murder and remains lodged at the Ottawa County Jail without bond, pending trial.

On **September 9**, 36-year-old Robert Gallup entered Ottawa County after exchanging gunfire with police from a neighboring jurisdiction and fleeing the scene. Despite a bullet wound to his arm, Gallup swam across the Grand River and entered Georgetown Township where he stole a U-haul box truck and led police on a chase. Gallup intentionally rammed numerous police cruisers and drove recklessly through neighbors' lawns while striking mailboxes, trees, street signs and vehicles. A Sheriff's Office Patrol Lieutenant was eventually able to disable the U-haul and take Gallup into custody. He was charged with thirteen (13) various crimes and awaits trial.

On **September 18**, at approximately 2:21 a.m. deputies responded to a shooting at the Canvas Apartment complex off 48th Avenue in Allendale Township. Investigation on scene showed that four people had been struck by gunfire, along with several vehicles and buildings. Following an altercation, more than twenty shots were fired by at least three subjects. 23-year-old DeJarion Blackshire was identified at the primary shooter and was charged with Assault with Intent to Murder and Felony Firearm. He is awaiting trial.

On **December 17**, deputies responded to Mount Blanc Lane in Allendale Township on reports of a house fire with two individuals possibly still inside the home. Upon arrival, responders located 28-year-old Angelica Del Villar Garcia and her six-year-old son, Nehemia. Both were deceased. There was fire damage in the bedroom and on the stove in the kitchen. MSP Fire investigators assisted and determined the fire was intentionally lit in at least three locations in the home, including the bed where Nehemia was found. Investigation showed that Angelica was about to be evicted from her home the upcoming week. This case was determined to be a murder-suicide.

Cold Case Investigations

The cold case team has re-examined several cases of unidentified human remains in Ottawa County. The advancements in DNA technology have provided investigators a new tool in many unsolved cases. In 2021, the Cold Case Team was able to use genetic genealogy technology to identify Shelly Kephart, AKA Shelly Christian as the victim of an unsolved 1994 homicide.

In 2022, detectives continued to investigate the circumstances surrounding her disappearance from Minnesota and what may have led to her death. Shelly was a mother to three children. Investigators hope anyone who knew Shelly in Michigan will come forward. The smallest piece of information could help solve this case and bring closure for Shelly's family members.

Detectives have also collaborated with area agencies, who are investigating a string of mid-1990s murders in the greater Grand Rapids area.

The **Cold Case Team** has also completed extensive investigation into the genealogy of the unknown victim found murdered in Blendon Township in 1967. In that case, detectives exhumed the body of the unknown female in July of 2020 to obtain a DNA sample to further the efforts of identifying the victim. The investigation is on-going.

Criminal Sexual Assault Investigations

The Sheriff's Office works actively with the **Ottawa County Children's Advocacy Center (CAC)**, located in Holland Township. The Sheriff's Office maintains a minimum of two detectives assigned to the Children's Advocacy Center. During 2022, 260 child victims were referred to the Advocacy Center. Detectives investigated and/or reviewed 1,050 Criminal Sexual Conduct and Child Abuse cases.

The **Investigative Division** also reviewed 888 notices from Child Protective Services (CPS) during the course of 2022. These Law Enforcement Notifications (LENs) were all reviewed and/or investigated by detectives. Many of these LENs resulted in criminal investigations.

Friend of the Court Investigator

Since May 2001, the Sheriff's Office has had a deputy assigned to work with the **Ottawa County Friend of the Court Office**. Two deputies are assigned to the Friend of the Court. These deputies assist with the collection of past due child support and the arrest of those deemed negligent in their support obligation.

The deputies also make contact with many people to establish jurisdiction, serve child support paperwork and conduct DNA swabs to establish paternity. During 2022, their work resulted in many arrests while investigating civil and felony child neglect/non-support cases. These investigations resulted in the collection of child support owed to dependent families in the amount of \$44,494.



The booting program added \$6,820 for a total of \$51,314 collected. In addition, the deputies contacted 412 individuals that were served with Friend of the Court paperwork and performed 93 DNA swabs.

Forensic Services Unit

The **Forensic Services Unit (FSU)** is staffed with one full time Evidence Technician and one part time Scientific Support Specialist. They are employed to handle the intake and disposition of all evidence and property received by the Sheriff's Office. In addition, fifteen (15) Deputies and one (1) Sergeant have received specialized training related to Crime Scene Investigation and respond to a variety of crime scenes to process DNA, fingerprints, photographs and collect trace evidence.

The **FSU staff** respond to major case investigations for the detection, documentation, collection, and preservation of evidence. They are involved in testing and preparing evidence for court presentation. The FSU staff also coordinate advanced scientific testing of evidence with State and Federal crime labs.

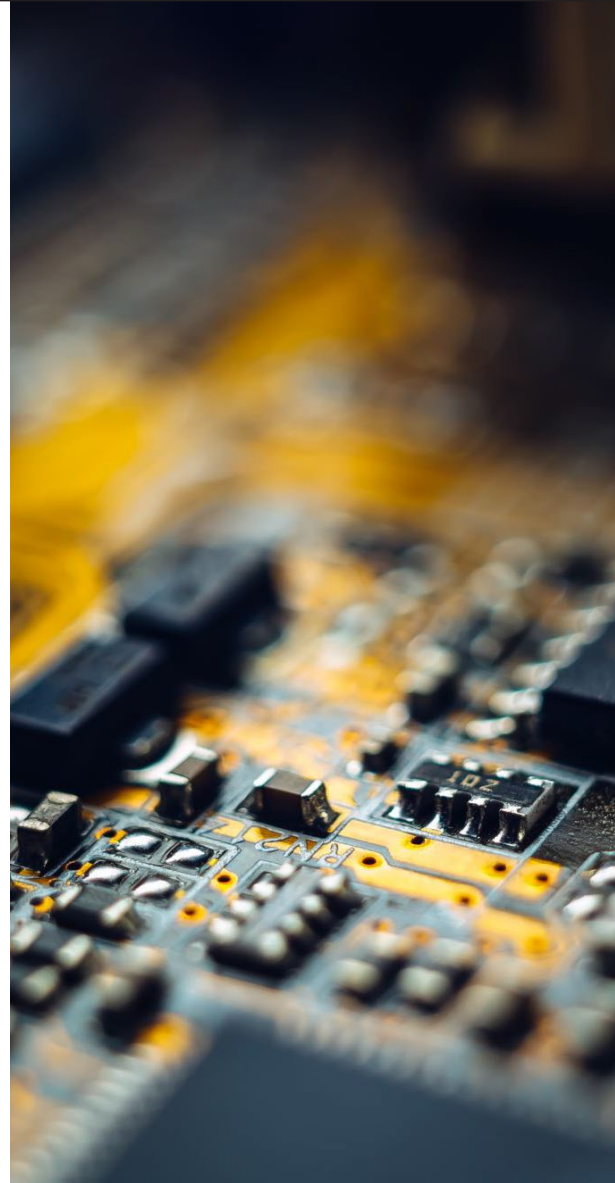
Computer Forensics

The Sheriff's Office maintains one **Certified Forensic Computer Examiner** for on-site investigations. Requests for digital media examination continue to increase.

In 2012, the Sheriff's Office and the Holland Department of Public Safety implemented a joint **Digital Forensics Lab**. This lab is a collaborative effort between agencies to coordinate investigative services for crimes involving digital media throughout Ottawa County. The goals of the lab are to protect communities we serve by preventing and investigating crimes involving digital media.

We strive to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of our investigations through the ability to obtain, analyze and interpret digital evidence for prosecution. Through this collaboration examiners obtained approximately \$7,000 in specialized forensic equipment and advanced training in 2022.

Our **forensic computer examiner** assists in internet investigations and forensic examinations of digital evidence. Technology changes in computers, cell phones, game systems, cameras, and other devices have made digital evidence an important element in the investigation and prosecution of many crimes. In 2022, the Detective took part in 199 investigations involving digital media. As part of these investigations, 378 forensic examinations of digital media were conducted.

Two Animal Control Deputies are responsible for handling animal complaints within Ottawa County. They routinely investigate complaints regarding the handling and care of companion animals. These include abuse and neglect situations, as well as dangerous animals.

Ottawa County Animal Control Deputies are concerned with the humane treatment of animals. Their primary goal, however, is to preserve human health. Educating the community on the need to license and vaccinate pets is very important.

Animal Control Deputies regularly pick-up stray dogs and assist in reuniting owners with lost pets.

In addition, they perform the following duties:

- » Investigating housing and care of farm domestics
- » Investigating animal cruelty/neglect complaints
- » Determining the origin of livestock losses
- » Enforcing state and County animal control laws, including licensing statutes
- » Enforcing township barking dog ordinances
- » Providing kennel inspections and licensing
- » Documenting animal bite reports
- » Providing information on wild animal issues

During 2022, the Sheriff's Office responded to more than 2,303 incidents regarding animal control issues. 258 were animal bite incidents. 2,132 animals were brought to the Humane Society.

The **Ottawa County Sheriff's Office K9 Unit** is comprised of four Deputies and their K9 partners. All of our K9 teams are Dual Purpose K9 Teams, meaning that the dogs are trained for both patrol work and in narcotics detection.

These specially trained K9s and their handlers are the most utilized specialty team within the Sheriff's Office. They provide general police services to the citizens of Ottawa County in addition to responding to K9 related calls. K9 handlers and their partners routinely respond to calls for service that include armed robberies, assaults, homicides, barricaded suspects, fugitive warrant arrests, missing persons, narcotics investigations, and a multitude of other calls.

The **Ottawa County Sheriff's Office K9 Teams** are instrumental to the law enforcement services provided to the citizens of Ottawa County and in ensuring the safety of our officers.

Recognizing that a significant amount of law enforcement response is reactive in nature, the administration of the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office has consistently moved in the direction of **community-oriented policing**.

Our goal is to work directly with local elected officials, schools, courts, businesses and community leaders to identify specific areas of need and develop strategies to address those needs. We believe that the proactive measures involved in community policing concepts have a direct impact on the reactive actions required of law enforcement. **Community-oriented policing** has proven to be a vital tool in dealing with the significant growth that has occurred within Ottawa County over the years.



These cooperative efforts have led to many successful Federal grant awards, such as the Department of Justice "Cops" Grant. These grants provided much of the financial foundation for the growth of community policing in Ottawa County. Continued support and partnerships by local units of government, schools, and the county have made community-oriented policing a stable, effective method of proactive law enforcement within Ottawa County.



Community policing assignments include; 1) the local community policing deputies, who consider the needs of the local unit of government; 2) the school resource deputies, who focus on school issues during the school year.

All community policing deputies carry a criminal investigation caseload as a part of their obligation to the community they serve.

School Resource Deputies

The primary focus of school resource deputies is the safety and security of the school campus. Well-publicized local and national events have demonstrated the need for the development of safety strategies and event crisis management to ensure the well-being of students and staff members. School resource deputies remain highly visible and assist in proactive problem solving to prevent or limit significant events from occurring on school grounds.



Apart from carrying a criminal investigation caseload resulting from crimes committed on campus, school resource deputies are skilled in working with young people.

Deputies attend many school academic and sporting events, and act as mentors to students, sharing their knowledge of life skills. Deputies also participate in classroom activities, such as teaching TEAM as well as speaking on health, government, and social media education related issues.

In addition, some deputies have extended their interest and talents to after school activities, such as coaching. Others assist by participating in theatre, music or charity based fundraising efforts in their school district.



The School Resource Deputy positions were initially secured by COPS grants but more recently maintained through partnerships between School Districts, local City and Townships, and Ottawa County.

Ride-Along Program

The Sheriff's Office maintains a Ride-Along Program to improve police/community relations, educate the public, and provide residents with an opportunity to understand police procedures and operations.

County residents who are at least eighteen years of age and are enrolled in a criminal justice educational program are eligible to apply.

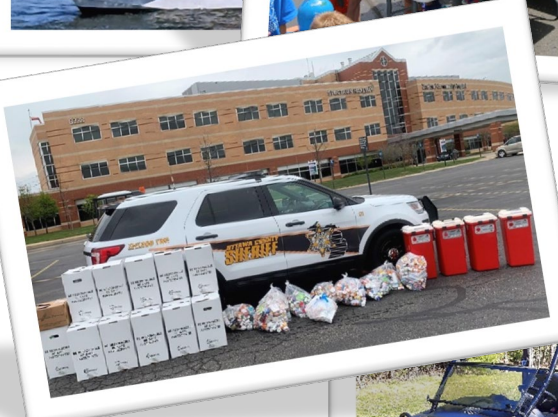

Community Programs

The School Resource Officers had to put this year's "Super Cool Sheriff's School" on hold. In past years, the event was held for kids entering 4th and 5th grades. A total of 200 youth participated in the popular event. Students spend the day engaging with law enforcement. They will have lessons and exercises teaching them about law enforcement and safety. The day built upon the important role of Ottawa County's eleven School Resource Officers. While some of their time is spent helping schools enforce rules or responding to school fights, more of the officers' days are invested in building relationships, mentoring, and being role models for kids. Having positive police interactions reinforces that the Ottawa County Sheriff's deputies are here to help and establishes a trust that can last a lifetime.

Community Policing Deputies organized the "Cram the Cruiser" event in the greater Zeeland and Spring Lake area in December & March. The focus of the event is donations of non-perishable food items, toys, clothing and hygiene products.

Deputies assigned to Jenison, Grand Haven and Hudsonville School Districts found a creative way to continue the "Shop with a Sheriff" program that has been a staple in Ottawa County for years. Partnerships with Meijer and Walmart generated over a \$20,000 donation.

College Internships

The Sheriff's Office also participates in a college internship program, in cooperation with the Criminal Justice Programs at Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College. The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office provides **Emergency Medical Units** in Holland, Park, and Georgetown Townships. These units are paid for by each Township as part of our partnership with the community.

E-Unit deputies are cross trained as police officers and paramedics. While on patrol,

they enforce laws, conduct criminal investigations, investigate traffic crashes, conduct traffic enforcement, and complete reports. However, they also are the first to respond to medical emergencies within their communities. The **E-Unit** deputies are licensed paramedics who offer medical care and treat their patient until which time they are turned over to a responding ambulance for transport to the hospital. **E-Unit** deputies are skilled in all aspects of pre-hospital medicine which includes the placement of advanced airways, the starting of IV's, EKG rhythm interpretation, and the administration of several life saving medications.

The **E-Units** responded to 13,811 incidents during 2022 which include both emergency and non-emergency types of calls. The call breakdown by area is depicted in the related tables.

As a result, the **Honor Guard Unit** stands ready to represent Ottawa County and the Sheriff's Office in a formal and professional manner. Hopefully, their services will never be needed to conduct a police funeral; however, the unit is prepared to assist in such an event if called upon to do so.

The Sheriff's Office had an interest in forming a department **Honor Guard Unit** for some time and we were able to accomplish this in 2009.

A police honor guard unit consists of members of an individual department who are specially trained to provide certain honorary functions. These functions typically involve special details associated with ceremonial events and police funerals.

The department managed to secure monetary donations from private groups and citizens that provided the funding needed to organize this unit. Through these donations all of the necessary uniforms and equipment needed for a formal **Honor Guard Unit** were obtained.





The **Sheriff's Office Marine Unit** operates five boats that are moored at the Coast Guard Stations in Grand Haven and Holland. The **Marine Unit** also utilizes two small vessels which can be trailered for patrolling inland lakes and the upper regions of the Grand River. Primary areas of patrol include Spring Lake, Grand River, Lake Macatawa, Lake Michigan, Pigeon Lake, Crockery Lake, Cranberry Lake, Cedar Lake, and Georgetown Lake.

The Sheriff's Office has coordinated and hosted the State Marine Training Academy sponsored by the Michigan Sheriff's Association. Fifty-four students from around the state were trained in the Michigan Marine Act, providing education in laws and procedure. Skills taught include accident investigation, towing a vessel, and detection of impaired operation.

The **Marine Unit** focuses efforts on education to gain voluntary compliance with marine laws and safety regulations. Enforcement continues to be a component of marine safety, but education and compliance with boating laws are vital in creating a safe and enjoyable boating environment.

The **Marine Unit** participated with multiple special event patrols such as Holland and Grand Haven 4th of July Fireworks, Grand Haven Coast Guard Festival, and the Grand Haven YMCA Triathlon.

Ottawa County Marine Unit participated with "Operation Dry Water" boating enforcement with the cooperation of area law enforcement and U.S. Coast Guard to make the public more aware of the dangers of drinking and boating. This event is targeted enforcement directed at intoxicated boaters with the goal of reducing alcohol related tragedies.

Deputies teamed with local businesses and volunteers to collect and distribute child, youth, and adult personal floatation devices (PFDs - life jackets). These PFDs were distributed at special events and by Deputies while on patrol to families that are in need of PFDs.

PFDs were also donated by local marinas and placed on "Loaner Boards" at State Parks and County parks within Ottawa County. The loaner boards provide parents or guardians of children the use of life jackets to assist in keeping their children safe while enjoying

water activities at the beach.

Due to high water levels from Lake Michigan during the 2021 season. The **Marine Unit** was able to conduct additional patrols targeting Slow No Wake areas using grants provided by the Michigan DNR.

Issues in Smith's Bayou area required extra attention of Marine Unit deputies. On busy weekends during the boating season, it is not unusual for 250 vessels or more to be anchored in the bayou at one time. The





Marine Unit has responded to complaints of loud music, reckless boating, and violations of Slow-No-Wake zones.

The **Marine Unit** continues to work with responsible boaters, property owners and local units of government to resolve problems, gain compliance, and to educate the public. The Marine Unit held multiple classes teaching 387 students in boater safety.

The **Sheriff's Office Marine Unit** consists of one full-time sergeant and 23 seasonal, part-time deputies. Sergeant Jon Knott currently oversees the Marine Unit and may be contacted at: jknott@miottawa.org.



Dive Team

In 2022, the **Ottawa County Sheriff's Office Dive Team** responded to 7 drownings. Two of the drownings required significant search and recovery efforts. The team responded to three separate incidents at local marinas in the Spring Lake and Grand River areas. They also responded to three incidents along Lake Michigan near Grand Haven and Ferrysburg. Additionally, the team assisted with evidence recovery.

The **Dive Team** assisted other public safety agencies with an incident that occurred on Buck Creek in Kent County. The Ottawa Dive Team took part in eight training dives within waters of Ottawa County. Additionally, they participated in three days of dive exercises at the Michigan DNR RAM Center located at Higgins Lake in Roscommon County.

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office continued to utilize the service of volunteers in our Volunteers in Police Service (VIPS), which was originally established in 2006. Over the course of the year, 13 members of this group volunteered their time to the citizens of Ottawa County.

The VIPS Program assists the Sheriff's Office in several key areas which include vehicle transfers, home security checks, handicapped parking enforcement, processing abandoned vehicles, as well as offering courtesy transportation to prisoners released from the Ottawa County Jail needing a ride back to their communities.

The volunteers also participate in various community events such as National Night Out, local fire department open houses, and community fairs.

The volunteers operate out of the Georgetown and Fillmore offices. They typically work together in teams of two, and there are usually two teams on every weekday. The services provided by this group directly benefit the community; as well as our patrol staff by freeing up their time to focus on patrol related issues. In addition to traffic enforcement conducted by routine road patrol and community policing units, the Sheriff's Office Traffic Services Unit consists of one sergeant and three full-time deputies.

The sergeant supervises the full-time traffic deputies, along with serious and fatal crash investigations and reconstruction, which includes forensic mapping of crash and crime scenes. In addition, this sergeant serves as a liaison between state and local offices regarding traffic safety issues. There are additional township-funded traffic units in Georgetown, Grand Haven, Holland, and Park Townships.

Traffic Services deputies enforce state traffic laws, investigate motor vehicle crashes, and serve as traffic enforcement training officers for all new deputies, in addition to providing traffic safety related educational programs to the public. Traffic Services supports the overall traffic safety mission in the department.

In all, there were 31,704 traffic contacts resulting in 17,316 people cited for 19,580 violations. Speeding tickets accounted for 42% of all tickets issued. Twenty fatal crashes claimed the lives of 22 people. Eleven of the fatal crashes were alcohol and/or drug related.

Drug Recognition Expert Program

In December of 2019 Deputy Adam Schaller became certified as a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) after successful completion of a lengthy advanced training program. He was quickly certified as an expert witness in both the District and Circuit courts and has been extremely successful.

What is a Drug Recognition Expert?

DRE officers receive advanced training in the investigation of impaired driving, drug trends, case law, and court testimony. DRE officers are required to maintain a high standard of proficiency, engage in continuing education, and must recertify every two years with IACP/OHSP. **DRE Officers** maintain an individual rolling-log, which documents their activity and accuracy. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) tracks and maintains data collected from DRE officers nationwide.

DRE officers are utilized in impaired driving investigations where drugs are suspected, and in fatal or serious injury crash investigations, to thoroughly investigate suspected impairment. The DRE officer conducts a **Drug Influence Evaluation** utilizing a standardized and systematic 12-step process. Steps include a brief medical check of vital signs, a suspect interview, SFST and ARIDE testing, and other specialized observations to determine whether a person is under the influence of a drug. The evaluation seeks to identify which specific drug category or combination of categories the person may be under the influence of.



The Ottawa County Drug Recognition Expert Cadre

Law enforcement agencies in Ottawa County currently have four certified DRE officers who coordinate responses to on-duty incidents and provide on-call, off-duty coverage for assistance in investigating impaired driving incidents involving drugs, or impaired driving incidents involving fatal or serious injury crashes. Ottawa County is additionally served by two DRE-trained assistant prosecuting attorneys who have

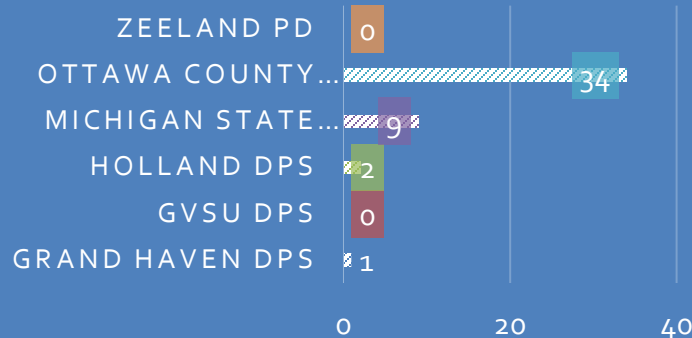
specialized training in impaired driving prosecution and relevant case law.



DRE officers also took part in the preliminary tests of a roadside oral fluid testing device in conjunction with the Michigan State Police and NHTSA to help determine the viability of these devices in future impaired driving incidents.

DREs in Ottawa County conducted 46 enforcement evaluations in 2022. Our Deputy conducted 34 evaluations. The graph below shows utilization of DREs by agency.

The **Victim Services Unit** is a volunteer group consisting of 23 dedicated individuals. The mission of the unit is to assist individuals who have suffered a tragedy (either a victim or a victim's family), thus permitting emergency personnel to concentrate their efforts on the incident at hand.

The **victim advocates** work in teams of two and are paged by the Ottawa County Central Dispatch Authority, upon request of law enforcement or emergency personnel at the scene of an incident. The **Victim Services Unit** has proven to be a very valuable asset and is available to all law enforcement and fire services personnel in Ottawa County upon request.

The **Victim Services Unit** is designed to provide support and comfort to victims and their families, thus minimizing the stress of the situation. Advocates make



referrals to appropriate agencies and services in the area and provide victims with information regarding access to the Judicial System and the Victim Compensation Board. They also serve as a go-between for victims, their families, and emergency service providers. In 2022, the unit responded to 96 calls for service.

Navigation Help

Finally, one can navigate through the report using the forward and backward buttons, which are found on nearly every page. Please refer to the Page Navigation section below.

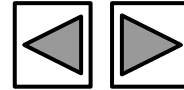
The icons in the lower right corner of your screen will help you move through this report. Following is an explanation for each icon.

Table of Contents



The Table of Contents (TOC) Icon appears on nearly every page. Click this to return to the TOC page. The TOC has links to the first page of each section. This may not be the most convenient way to navigate, but it provides the option for those who prefer to jump from section to section via the TOC.

Page Navigation



The arrows allow the reader to page forward and backward through the document and are available on most pages. If the forward button is colored, that signifies that there are additional pages within that particular section or sub-section. Some sub-sections consist of multiple pages.

Information Icon



The Information Icon is found in the Call History-Countywide and Call History-Local Units sections of the report.
