The Contractor has expressed an interest to start work in your neighborhood the week of March 30, 2015 in the following locations: Perry Street and 168th Avenue to Lakewood Boulevard.

We therefore, are notifying you, the landowner of the following:

1. **ACCESS:** Perry Street and 168th Avenue will have lane closures and road closures with a detour route set up during the course of construction, which is estimated to take 5 to 6 weeks depending on the weather and other factors. Emergency access will be available at all times.
2. **CLEARING:** It is our intent to minimize damage and/or removal of trees and bushes in residential areas.
3. **DRIVEWAYS:** Work will be conducted to minimize the duration of driveway closures. The Contractor will provide written notice to property owners or occupants 24 hours prior to closing residential driveways and 48 hours prior to closing commercial driveways. If your driveway is disturbed during construction, it will be restored to the standards required by the Ottawa County Road Commission. If you have any special access needs or medical concerns, please contact the Project Manager.
4. **LANDSCAPING:** It is our intent to try to work around landscaping, fences, out buildings and gardens, although in some cases it may not be possible. This is your notification to move seasonal landscape improvements and identify any underground irrigation lines or fences in the road right-of-way. The Contractor will carefully remove and replace all mailboxes, signs, fences, posts, borders and retaining walls encountered within the right-of-way, and repair any irrigation lines or underground fences disturbed during the work. The Contractor will be responsible for lawn restoration, but will not be replanting shrubs and perennials disturbed during the work.
5. **CONNECTION TO THE DRAIN:** Leads will be provided on your property if you are within the Park West Assessment District. You may connect a private drainage line to the lead at your cost. The Contractor will coordinate the final location of the lead with you extending the lead to the right-of-way line.
