## How are board members selected for the **Ottawa Area Intermediate School District?**

The Ottawa Area Intermediate School District (OAISD) has a Board of Education that consists of 5 members.

A meeting with all 11 school districts will take place on **Monday**, **June 7th**. At that meeting, each school district will cast one vote for each available position to be filled on the OAISD Board of Education.

There are two positions available in 2021. A **full term position**, with a term ending date of June 1, 2027, and a partial term position, with a term ending date of June 1, 2025.

Candidates who file to run for the OAISD Board of Education must select which office (full term or partial term) for which they are choosing to run.

To file for office, candidates must submit either a minimum of 40 petition signatures or pay a \$100 filing fee.





All filings must be submitted to the **Ottawa County Clerk's Office** by no later than Monday, May 10th.
