The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Drainage District Boundaries and Apportionments on the above date, time, and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Dry Intercounty Drain Drainage District boundaries and the tentative apportionments of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District with the Water Resources Commissioner or staff member. A map of the proposed Drainage District boundary revisions can be found enclosed with this notice and on the Water Resources Commissioner's website at: https://www.miottawa.org/departments/drain/.

The following is a list of any county, township, city, or village to be assessed: Ottawa County and Chester Township.

At the Day of Review:

- No appointment is necessary.
- The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals and make revisions where necessary.
- The computation of costs for the Drain will be available.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.

Comments submitted in advance must be received by the Water Resources Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure consideration.

Assessments & Appeals

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ottawa County Circuit Court within ten (10) days. You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days.


