The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments on the above date, time, and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefits for each parcel and municipality within the Midway Industrial Drain Drainage District.

At the Day of Review:

- No appointment is necessary.
- The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals and make revisions where necessary.
- The computation of costs for the Drain will be available.

Assessments & Appeals

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days.




