Yard Waste and Grass Clippings

During a recent drain inspection on the No. 31 drain. We identified multiple locations with yard waste and grass clippings in the drain. The photo below was taken during the inspection.

The Issue:

Grass clippings and yard waste causes issues impeding proper drainage and increases the need for drain maintenance. It also has an adverse effect on water quality. Fertilizers used in grass clippings add phosphorus and nitrogen into our water systems causing the increase of plant growth and algae blooms.

Illicit Discharge:

Grass clippings and yard waste are considered an illicit discharge because of the adverse effects it has on water quality. It is also considered a violation according to sec 412 of the Michigan Drain Code of 1956. Future violations after this drain cleaning will include fines for the costs of the cleanup, to the landowner responsible for the dumping.

What you can do with yard waste:

There are several ways to avoid/ properly depose of yard waste.

- Mow grass at a higher setting. At least 3 inches high. Allow grass clippings to stay in your yard.
- Add yard waste into your compost.
- Dispose of yard waste properly. Park Township's 2024 Waste Recycling is found on the other side of this letter.



We all play a part in keeping our waterways clean. Did you know that you live in Pine Creek Watershed? Currently impaired due to phosphorus and sedimentation inputs into the waterway.
