Debt Service Fund

Financial resources restricted for debt payments

Special Revenue Fund

Financial resources restricted or committed for specific purposes

General Fund

Financial resources not accounted for or reported in another fund; primary operating fund





Revenue Excluding Internal Sources






General Fund Budget







General Fund Expenses




Special Revenue Funds Budget
