This petition is signed by a number of freeholders with lands liable for assessment in the Boom Drain Drainage District, equal to at least half the number of freeholders whose lands would be traversed by the proposed drain.

Why did I receive a notice?

A petition was filed with the Ottawa County Water establishment, and construction of the proposed drain. it is your right to do so. All property owners with lands in the drainage district were sent a copy of the notice.

Does the Board of Determination decide what work gets done?

does not determine the scope or cost of the project. Further, the board of determination does not determine how much property owners and municipalities will be assessed.

Does the decision of the Board of Determination have to

contributes water to the drain. Each property and required. Only the members of the board of municipality within the drainage district pays for determination vote. The attendees at the meeting do not vote, but instead provide testimony to the board members to assist in their determination.

Do I have to attend the Board of Determination?

Yes. If a person feels aggrieved by the board's determination of necessity, he/she may institute an No, the board of determination decides necessity, but action in circuit court within 10 days. MCL280.72a.
