DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS/ASSESSMENTS

The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments on the above date, time and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit/assessment for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District. The Water Resources Commissioner and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review.

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance. You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's determination of apportionments/assessments within ten (10) days by making an application to the Ottawa County Probate Court for the appointment of a board of review.
