The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Hecksel Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Hecksel Drain will be let in one section as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE FOLLOWING QUANTITIES ARE APPROXIMATE AND THAT FINAL PAYMENT WILL BE BASED ON MEASURED QUANTITIES:

*350 feet of open channel excavation (2-foot bottom width, 10-foot average depth), 981 feet of open channel excavation (1-foot bottom width, 2.5-foot average depth), 250 square yards of rock riprap, 1,053 feet of 18-inch PE storm sewer (7-foot average depth), 100 feet of 12-inch PE storm sewer culvert (3-foot average depth), and all related work and restoration.*

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at the Office of the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner and available for review to interested parties. Bids will be made and received in accordance with these documents. Bidding Documents, including plans and specifications, may be examined at the following location:

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained upon payment of a ***\$40 non-refundable*** deposit. An additional ***non-refundable*** charge of **\$20** will be required for sending out Bidding Documents.

A security deposit in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

**A mandatory pre-bid conference for the contract will be held on Thursday, May 30, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner's Office, 12220 Fillmore Street, West Olive, MI 49460.**

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If

no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Hecksel Drain Drainage District boundaries and apportionment of benefit with the Water Resources Commissioner or a staff member. A map of the proposed Drainage District boundary revisions can be found on the reverse side of this notice and on the Water Resources Commissioner's website at: <https://www.miottawa.org/Departments/Drain/notices.htm>.

The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ottawa County Circuit Court within ten (10) days, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days.
