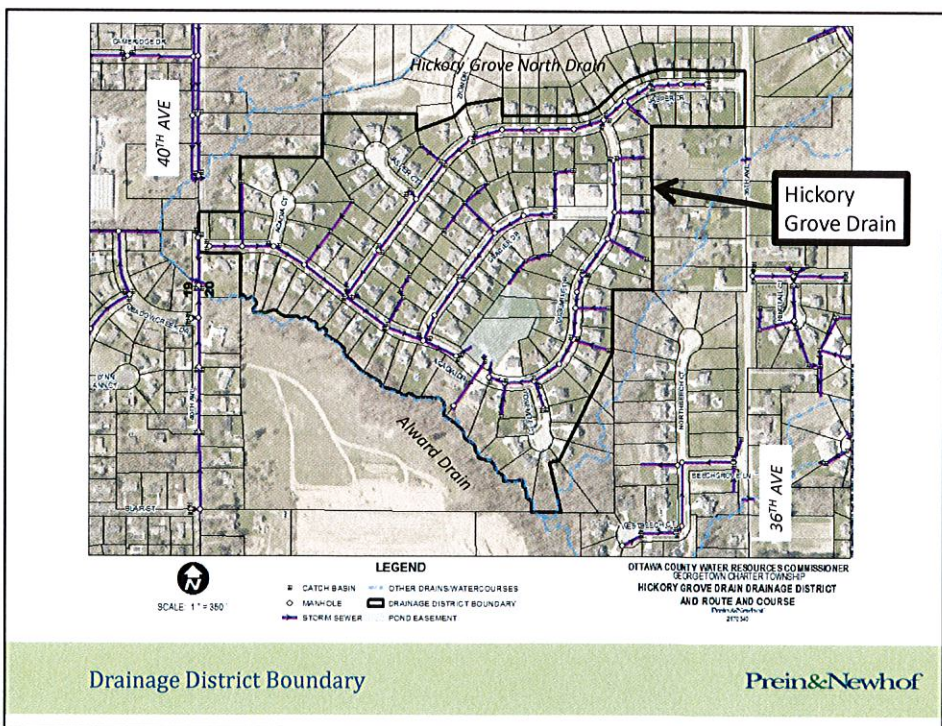
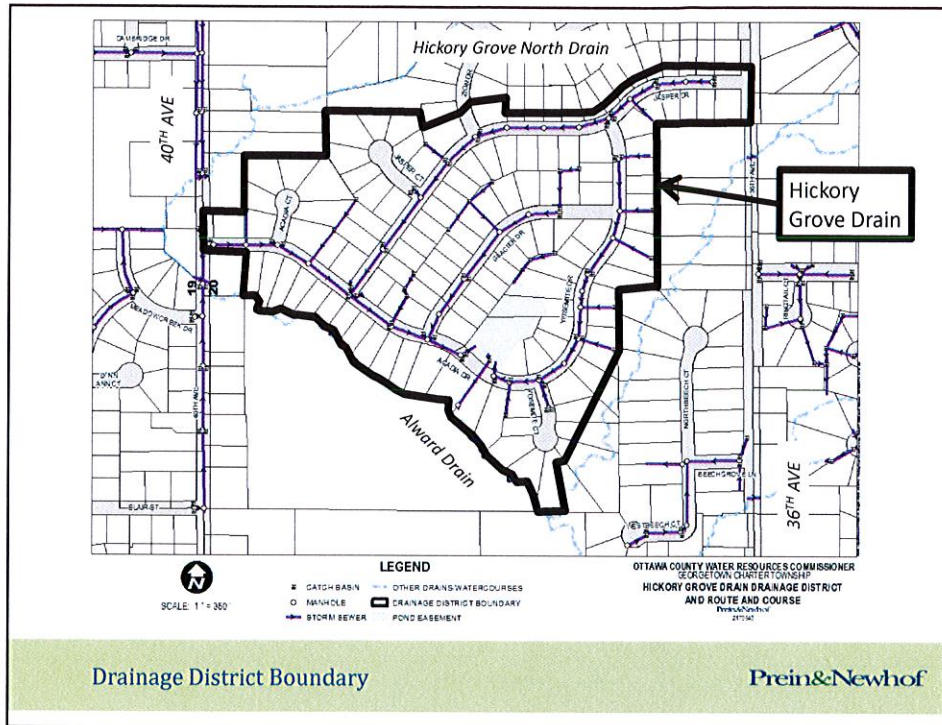
**Hickory Grove Drain  
Meeting of Board of Determination**

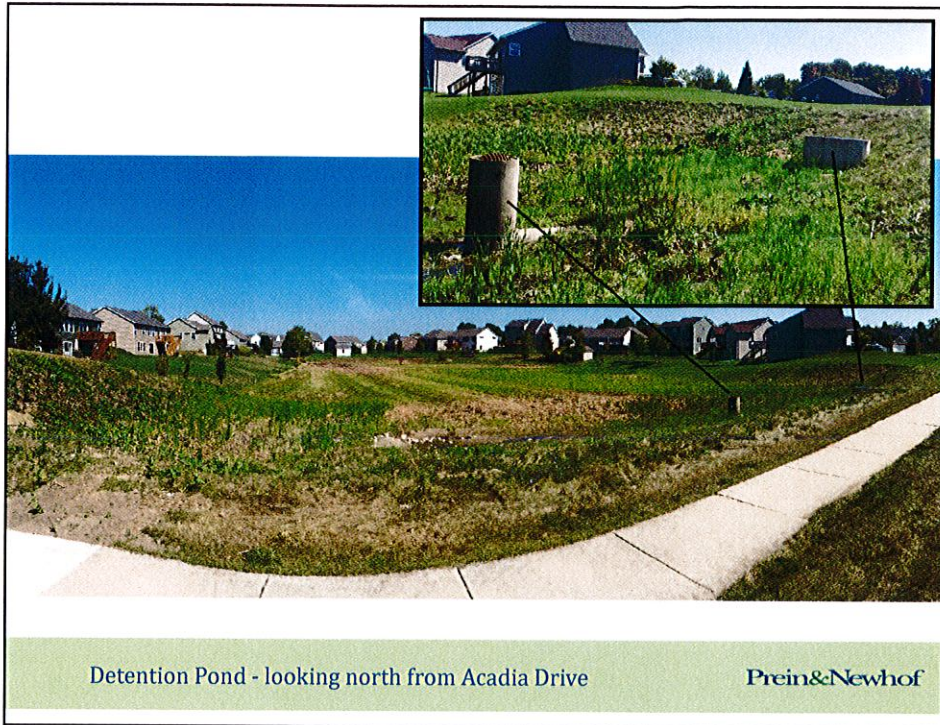
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## Hickory Grove Drain

- Petitioned by Georgetown Charter Township on 8/29/2017 under Chapter 8 of the Michigan Drain Code of 1956 to maintain and improve a county drain.
- Four plats are a part of the Hickory Grove Drain:
  - Hickory Grove - (2001) *when the main pond was installed*
  - Hickory Grove No. 2 - (2003)
  - Hickory Grove No. 3 - (2003)
  - Hickory Grove No. 4 - (2005)
- Hickory Grove Drain established as Section 433 Drain in 2001
- Branches to the Hickory Grove Drain were added with the additional phases of development.

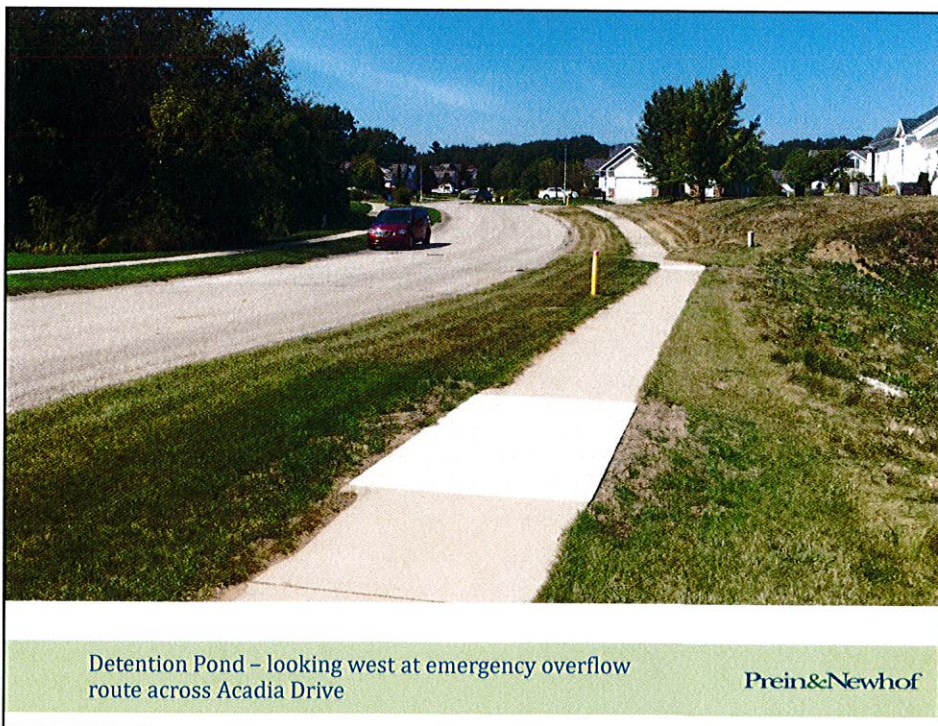






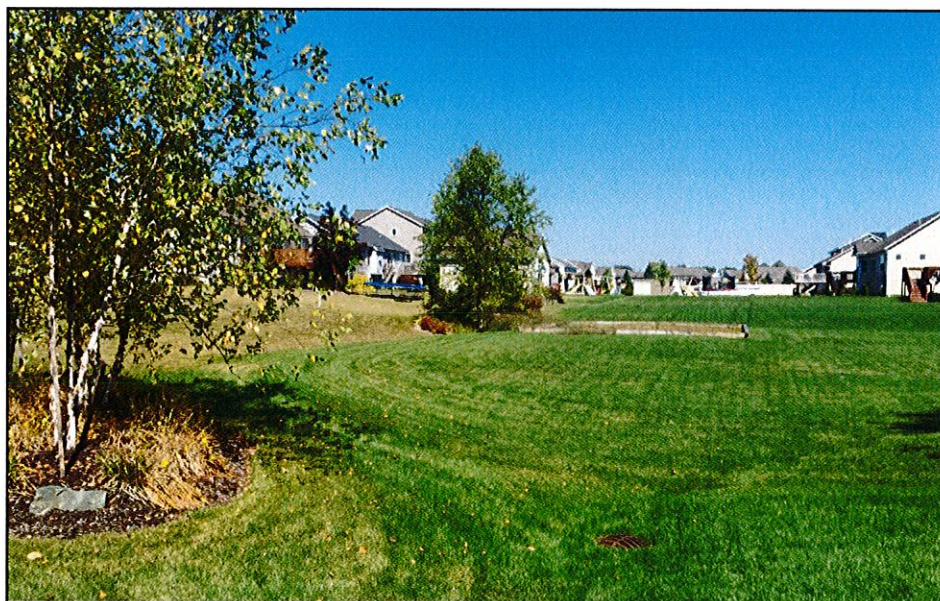
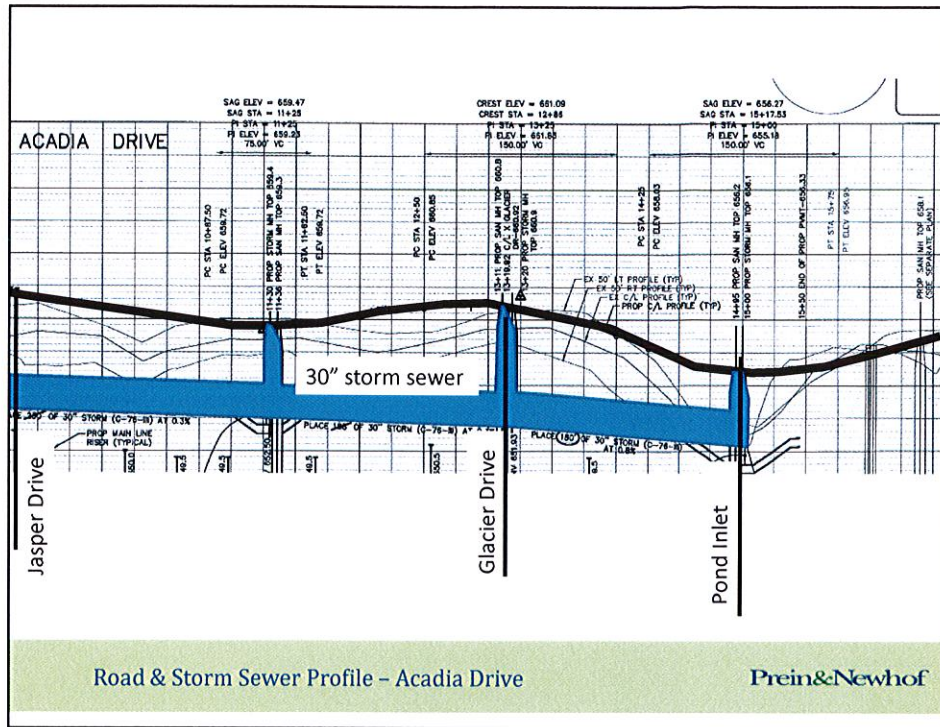
Detention Pond - looking north from Acadia Drive

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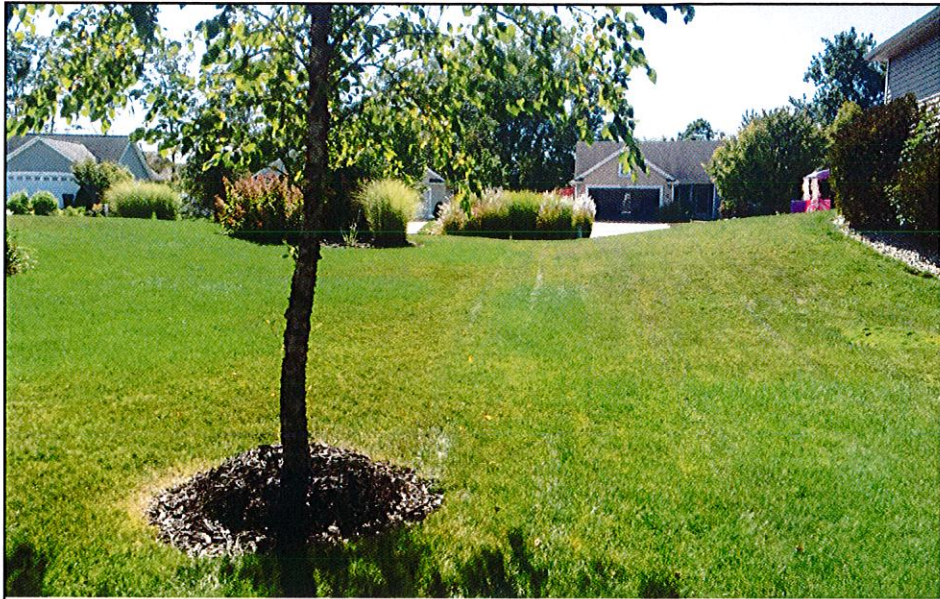
Detention Pond – looking west at emergency overflow route across Acadia Drive

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## Hickory Grove Drain – Next Steps

Purpose of Board of Determination is to hear public and municipal comments about the petition and determine necessity.

- Hear from the public
- Board to Determine necessity of petition received from Georgetown Charter Township
- If a project is deemed necessary:
  - Survey & Design proceeds to determine scope and alternatives
  - Easement Acquisition/Permits (if required)
  - Project Bid and Construction
  - Day of Review
- If petition is deemed not necessary:
  - No further action will occur



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
