

NOTICE OF LETTING

DATE, TIME & LOCATION: June 7, 2018 at 2:00 p.m., 12220 Fillmore, Room 141, West Olive

The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Hickory Grove Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The project consists of furnishing all material and constructing the following:

446 l.f. of 42 inch concrete storm sewer

308 l.f. of 12-24 inch diameter storm sewer

Detention pond grading and swale construction

300 tons of bituminous pavement

Including all necessary appurtenances and restoration

Plans and specifications are available for viewing at the office of the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner, 12220 Fillmore, Room 141, West Olive, Michigan. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS

DATE, TIME & LOCATION: June 18, 2018, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., 12220 Fillmore, Room 141, West Olive

The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments on the above date, time and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District. The Water Resources Commissioner and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review.

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance. You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's determination of apportionments within ten (10) days by making an application to the Ottawa County Probate Court for the appointment of a board of review.
