ORDER FOR LAYING OUT AND DESIGNATING A DRAINAGE DISTRICT

LOVELL PARK DRAIN

Whereas, An application in writing, dated the 12th day of October, 2015, has been made and filed with me, the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner, for the Laying Out and Designating of a Drainage District.

The application was signed by Spring Lake Township, a municipality, which will be liable for an assessment on the Drain.

And Whereas, the County Treasurer has provided a statement that less than 0% of the lands in the proposed drainage district owe taxes and special assessments over the preceding three years.

And Whereas, as a further means of determining the practicability of the proposed drain, I did cause a survey to be made by **Prein & Newhof**.

Now, Therefore, I do hereby determine that the Application for the Laying Out and Designating a Drainage District for the drain should be granted, and I do hereby determine from the survey that the drain is practicable, in accordance with the survey which is more particularly specified below.

And I do further determine that the name or number of the Drain shall be the "Lovell Park Drain" by which name it shall hereafter be known and recorded.

It is further ordered and determined that the commencement, route and terminus of the drain and the width, length and depth thereof shall be in accordance with the survey, as described in the attached Exhibit A.

It is further ordered and determined that a description of the lands constituting the Drainage District and the cities, villages and townships, county roads and state highways which are benefitted by the proposed drain and therefore may be liable to assessment are more fully described in the attached Exhibit B.
