PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Chapter 20 of Act 40, Public Acts of Michigan 1956, a petition was filed with the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner by Grand Haven Charter Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, and the Ottawa County Road Commission, Ottawa County, Michigan, requesting said Water Resources Commissioner to locate, establish, and construct the Mercury Drive Drain, the description to be as follows:

The assignment of legal authority of the Mercury Drive Drain by establishing the orphan drain as a county drain. The establishment of the Mercury Drive Drain provides the drain and drainage district the legal mechanism in place to maintain/improve the drain and fund maintenance and improvement projects.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Drainage Board for the Mercury Drive Drain has considered said petition and made a tentative determination that the petition is sufficient and that project is practicable. The Drainage Board has further determined to continue the name "Mercury Drive" as the name of the drain, and has made a tentative determination that the following public corporations should be assessed for the cost of the project as follows:

OTTAWA COUNTY, Michigan for benefits to the public health.

CITY OF GRAND HAVEN, Ottawa County, Michigan for benefits to the public health.

GRAND HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP, Ottawa County, Michigan for benefits to the public health.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Drainage Board intends to meet at the above date, time and location for the purpose of hearing any objections to the proposed drain and the petition for the drain, and to the matter of assessing cost of the drain to the designated public corporations named above. However, due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health crisis and consistent with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act and Michigan Executive Order 2020-48, the hearing will alternatively be held through remote electronic access, as provided in this Notice, if public gatherings are unable to be held due to federal, state, or local orders, laws, regulations, and guidelines.
