The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage Districts.

The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drains will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. There are no expected assessments at this time, as Holland Charter Township will be covering the cost of the projects that were found necessary for the Drains. If, in the future, drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner of their County at the number listed above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days.

The following is a description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment Districts of the Drains, as well as a list of any county, township, city, or village to be assessed at-large:

(1) Imperial Estates North Drain
