The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Old Macatawa Court Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Old Macatawa Court Drain will be bid in section(s), each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth in the bid documents; briefly described as follows:

Clearing of marked trees, earth excavation, berming of spoil onsite, and trucking of spoil offsite to expand two existing stormwater retention basins serving the Old Macatawa Court condominium development; installation of an 18-inch diameter culvert under Old Macatawa Court entrance drive including flared end sections and riprap end treatment; pavement and turf restoration and landscaping.

Plans and specifications are available for viewing at the office of the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner, 12220 Fillmore, Room 141, West Olive, Michigan.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Drain Drainage District boundary and apportionment of benefit with the Water Resources Commissioner and/or other staff. A map of the proposed Drainage District boundary is enclosed and can be found on the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner's website at:

The following is a description of the lands constituting the Drainage District of said drain: All those lands located in the SW 1/4 of Section 35, T5N, R16W, Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, bounded by a line described as: Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 15 of Heneveld's Supervisor's Plat No. 10, as recorded in Liber 9, Page 1, Ottawa County Records; thence S67°12'00"W 10.81 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING for this description; thence South 795.74 feet along the west line of the east 10.0 feet of said Lot 15; thence continuing South 280 feet to a point 16.5 feet north of the southeast corner of said Lot 15; thence

West 81 feet; thence N33°12'17"W 66 feet; thence West 107 feet; thence N46°37'W 36 feet; thence West 24 feet; thence North 125 feet; thence West 58 feet; thence North 75 feet more or less to the South line of the North 140 feet of the South 436.5 feet of said Lot 15; thence West 78 feet more or less to the west line of said Lot 15; thence North 624 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 15; thence continuing North 33 feet more or less to the centerline of South Shore Drive; thence N67°12'00"E 436.67 feet; thence South 36 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Total acreage in drainage district is 8.59 acres, more or less.

The Water Resources Commissioner and/or other staff will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions if necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected by installment, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ottawa County Circuit Court, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days of the Day of Review.
