The Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments and Drainage District Boundaries on the above date, time and location. Due to the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), if our office is not open to the public, then the office will hold the Day of Review electronically. Individuals may call or email us with any questions.

The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District and to review the description of lands comprising the Warber Drain. A map of the proposed Drainage District Boundary is enclosed and can be found on the Ottawa County Water Resources Commissioner's website at:

The Water Resources Commissioner and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected by installment, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Water Resources Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Water Resources Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ottawa County Circuit Court, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Ottawa County Probate Court within ten (10) days of the Day of Review.

The following is a description of the lands constituting the Warber Drain Drainage District:

Part of the west half section of section 27, all quarter sections of section 28, the east half section of section 29, northeast quarter section of section 32, north half of section 33, and the northwest quarter section of section 34, T08N, R16W of Grand Haven Charter Township and the City of Grand Haven.
